December Message

God with us – the visited planet

If we were in any doubt about the significance of planet earth to the human race, it was highlighted last month both by the COP26 conference, and by the visit of a gigantic globe art installation to Keele University Chapel. There may be around 700,000,000,000,000,000,000 other planets in the universe, but our earth appears to be only one within reach that can support human life in any numbers!

Christians believe that the earth has another particular significance - in being the 'Visited planet'. For the Christmas story is not just about the arrival of new human ruler in humble circumstances: but about the maker of the universe taking human form on planet earth. One of the bible verses telling of the birth of Jesus that highlights this comes in Matthew's gospel which explains that

'All this took place to fulfil what the Lord had spoken by the prophet: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel (which means, God with us).'

It's possible that the pandemic will again bring restrictions on how we can celebrate the family side of Christmas, and even on our church worship. But they still won't be able to stop us celebrating the good news of God coming to our world in Jesus – and of his continuing presence, in a spiritual way, with all who follow him.

Sunday Services

There's a warm invitation to join us for services.

No booking is required. All ages are welcome.

9.00am service

As numbers are generally rather smaller for this service, it's very easy for us to have over 2m spacing between households, and we ask those who are able to wear masks. In addition, our very airy building means that, for more COVID vulnerable people, the infection risk is able to be kept extremely low.

10.30am service (&6.30 Carols on Dec 19th)

We enjoy singing together; although it's still possible to have a bit of space between households, if desired.

10.30 services include 3-10's activities, and refreshments are served in the hall afterwards.

6.30 pm service

Over the winter this will almost always take place in our 'parish room' below the church, directly accessible from our rear car park. Though we will be distanced, it's not as big a space as the church and so mask-wearing is expected (unless exempt).

While we are continuing with this, it also gives an opportunity for people to get a bit of a preview of our worship - before hopefully deciding to join us in-person.
