

Replacement of Church Hall ... we have now heard that last month's twilight survey by Elite Ecology did not observe any signs of bats, so we are anticipating that we will be able to go ahead with the project fairly soon. Our builders, Fords of Blythe Bridge will however need first to put in a request for existing utilities to be disconnected, book the demolition contractors, submit some other paperwork to the council etc., so we are not yet sure of exact dates.

Door to Door Introductions ... on the evening of Wednesday 3rd July (6.30-8.00 pm) we are planning to make personal contact with those living in some of the streets of St Andrew's Parish, while we have the benefit of lighter evenings. Naomi Update ... Naomi Savage, our Children and Families Worker, has now begun chemotherapy. Following the results of a recent scan, this will need to be for a longer period and at a higher dosage than had been previously anticipated. Please do keep praying for her. She has now completed the 5 consecutive daily doses for the first month and is feeling okay, albeit with lower energy levels.

All this means that sadly Naomi will not be returning to work before she concludes her time on our books on 31st July. However, she is very hopeful of being able to join us at the 10.45 am service on 7th July and for cake afterwards (and maybe for some of the events in the days just before and after that too) to enable us to express our thanks for her ministry and say goodbye.
