Venezuela Earthquake Appeal ... Tearfund, as part of the Disasters Emergency Committee have launched an emergency appeal to offer

humanitarian support through their local partner churches in the region. At least 1,700 people have been killed, and more than 5,000 are injured. This number is expected to rise as an estimated 50,000 people are still reported missing. The destruction is widespread. Hundreds of buildings have collapsed. Families have lost everything in a matter of minutes. You can give to support the relief work via [Tearfund's website](#) or by calling 020 3906 3906.
